### SHEPHERD (8-1, 6-1) vs. WV STATE (6-2, 4-2) RAM STADIUM • SHEPHERDSTOWN, WV SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2007 • 1 P.M.

SHEPHERDSTOWN, W. Va. -- Senior All-American candidate Dervon Wallace (Lusby, MD/Calvert) rushed 37 times for 280 yards and three touchdowns to lead 15th-ranked Shepherd University to a 38-21 win over West Liberty in WVIAC football action at Ram Stadium on Saturday.

Shepherd took a 7-0 lead with 10:35 left in the second quarter when junior quarterback Tyler Lazear (Bethesda, MD/Walt Whitman) teamed with sophomore wide receiver Nasser Muhammad (Silver Spring, MD/Sidwell Friends) on a 31-yard scoring play to give the Rams a 7-0 lead.

Wallace broke loose for a career-long 86-yard scoring jaunt with 7:38 left in the first quarter increase the Ram lead to 14-0.

Shepherd took a 17-0 lead into the break when junior kicker Bryan Beverage (Romney, WV/Hampshire) connected on a 24-yard field goal with 23 seconds left in the first quarter.

The Rams increased their lead to 24-0 when Lazear connected with junior tight end Ryan Lavin (Centreville, VA/Westfield) on a 33-yard scoring strike with 7:34 left in the third quarter.

Hilltopper quarterback Zach Amedro tossed a six-yard touchdown pass to Almonzo Banks to cut the lead to 24-7 with 2:14 left in the third quarter.

Shepherd answered back on a three-yard scoring run by Wallace with 13:29 left in the fourth quarter to increase the lead to 31-7.

Eddie Hill hauled in a 13-yard scoring pass from Amedro to get the Hilltoppers to within 17 points at 31-14 with 10:21 left in the fourth quarter.

Wallace, who earned WVIAC Offensive Player of the Week honors for the second straight week, scored his third touchdown of the day on a two-yard plunge with 1:47 left in the contest to give the Rams a 38-14 advantage.

Amedro teamed with Banks on a 23-yard scored with 31 seconds remaining to complete the scoring.

Lazear completed 9-of-16 passes for 156 yards, while Amedro was 37-of-57 for 383 yards.

Banks had 15 receptions for 139 yards to lead the West Liberty receivers. Lavin (63 yards), Muhammad (47) and senior wide receiver Mark Springirth (Germantown, MD/Watkins Mill) (46) each had three catches for the Rams.

The Ram defense was led by junior cornerback Dustin Smith (Germantown, MD/Northwest) with 14 tackles, including 13 solos. Junior defensive end Mike Spiegelberg (Silver Spring, MD/Springbrook) added seven tackles with six solo stops and a pair of sacks. The Rams sacked Amedro seven times on the day.

Smith and junior cornerback Taros Harris (Cheasapeake Beach, MD/Calvert) each had interceptions for the Rams.

#### A REIGN OF EXCELLENCE

Head Coach Monte Cater is now in his 21st season at the helm of the Shepherd football program. The Rams have had a great deal of success since Cater arrived in 1987 as they have won 10 WVIAC titles in 20 seasons. In that time the Rams have made two trips to the NAIA Playoffs and four trips to the NCAA II Playoffs with a pair of back-to-back appearances (1998-99 and 2005-06). Below is a list of where Cater ranks on the all-time victories and all-time titles lists in the WVIAC.

### SHEPHERD'S MAGIC NUMBERS

If the Rams score 24 or more points, there is a good chance they will come out on top. Shepherd owns a 229-9 (.962) all-time record when reaching the magical 24-point mark. Included in that record is a 102-6 (.944) record since 1990 and a 108-8 (.931) mark under Cater.

The Rams sport a 340-75-26 (.800) all-time record when holding the opposition to 14 points or less. Currently, Shepherd has won 66 of its last 67 games when holding the opposition to 14 or less and owns an 88-3-1 (.962) record since 1990 when turning the trick. Shepherd is 99-7-1 (.929) under Cater in such games.

Shepherd is 117-93-26 (.550) all-time in games decided by seven points or less. Shepherd has a 35-21-1 (.622) record since 1990 and a 39-30-1 (.564) mark under Cater in games decided by seven or less.

150

Another key to victory is the Shepherd running game. Shepherd is 138-23-2 (.853) since 1980 in games that it rushes for 150 or more yards. Since 1990, the record is 86-11-1 (.882) and under Cater it is 96-17-1 (.846).

### Anything Less than 100

Defensively, the Rams will try to contain the running game and force teams to pass. If they hold the opposition to under 100 yards rushing, the odds on a win go up dramatically. Since 1980, the Rams are 116-16-1 (.875) when holding teams to less than 100 yards. Since 1990, Shepherd is 81-11 (.880) in such games and 89-14 (.864) under Cater.

West Virginia State (6-2, 4-2) is coming off a 26-21 upset victory over Glenville State at home last Saturday.

Sophomore quarterback **Kevin O'Brien** (6-4, 225) led the Yellow Jackets as he completed 21-of-31 passes for 369 yards and two touchdowns. He also rushed for another score.

Sophomore wide receiver **Deonta Landis** (6-3, 185) hauled in six catches for 122 yards, including a 42-yard touchdown reception.

Freshman wide receiver **Ryan Douglas** (6-4, 215) had two grabs for 100 yards. Sophomore tight end **Mike Jones** (6-5, 270) added four catches for 49 yards, while freshman wide receiver **Jermain King** (6-3, 215) had three receptions for 55 yards.

Sophomore running back **Brian Mitchell** (5-8, 170) led the State ground game as he rushed 16 times for 110 yards.

The Yellow Jacket offense was a 4-for-7 in the red zone.

The State defense was led by sophomore defensive back **Andrew Eggleton** (5-11, 210).

Eggleton recorded a game-high 18 tackles with six solo stops. He also had the team's only interception.

Sophomore defensive back **Rafael Lee** (5-10, 205) added 15 tackles, while freshman defensive back **Jerome Powell** (5-10, 175) and sophomore defensive lineman **Brandon Thomas** (6-3, 305) added 11 stops each.

Senior cornerback **Brandon Truesdale** (5-11, 170) contributed six tackles, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery, and a pair of pass breakups.

Junior kicker/wide receiver **Larry Hinton** (6-2, 190) connected on field goals of 22 and 29 yards. He also had an 11-yard touchdown reception in the third quarter which provided the margin of victory for the Yellow Jackets.

Eggleton punted four times for a 29.0 average with one inside the 20-yard line.

Freshman **Stephen Bumpus** (6-1, 175) had four punt returns for 93 yards and a kickoff return for 30 yards to pace the return game.
