

### SHEPHERD (5-1, 3-1) vs. CONCORD (0-6, 0-4)

CALLAGHAN STADIUM • ATHENS, WV  
SATURDAY, OCTOBER 13, 2007 • 1 P.M.

SHEPHERDSTOWN, W.Va. -- Junior quarterback Tyler Lazear (Bethesda, MD/Walt Whitman) completed 11-of-14 passes for 218 yards and three touchdowns and senior running back Dervon Wallace (Lusby, MD/Calvert) rushed 25 times for 138 yards and a touchdown to lead 21st-ranked Shepherd University to a 49-13 win over University of Charleston in WVIAC football action at Ram Stadium on Saturday.

Charleston took a 6-0 lead with 2:23 left in the first quarter when quarterback DaRonte Hunter scored on a two-yard run.

The Rams answered back with 12:33 remaining in the second quarter when Lazear teamed with sophomore wide receiver Nasser Muhammad (Silver Spring, MD/Sidwell Friends) on a two-yard scoring pass. Junior kicker Bryan Beverage (Romney, WV/Hampshire) added the extra point to give the Rams a 7-6 lead.

Minutes later Shepherd took a 14-6 lead when Wallace raced 28 yards for a score.

The Golden Eagles got within 14-13 with 2:45 left in the second quarter when Hunter tossed a 61-yard touchdown pass to Terrance Spencer.

Lazear teamed with freshman wide receiver Nikkolai Norrell (Richmond, VA/Hermitage) on a 44-yard scoring strike with 2:45 left in the second quarter to up the Ram lead to 21-13.

Shepherd took a 28-13 lead into intermission when freshman Deante Steele (Woodbridge, VA/ Potomac) fielded a Wes Sherrill punt at the Shepherd 32-yard line and raced 68 yards for a score with 54 second left in the half. Steele, who earned WVIAC Co-Special Teams Player of the Week honors, became the first Ram since Dustin Dudinski (2005 vs. WVU Tech) to return a punt for a touchdown.

Lazear fired a 70-yard scoring strike to senior wide receiver Mark Springirth (Germantown, MD/Watkins Mill) to up the Ram lead to 35-13 with 12:22 left in the third quarter.

Freshman running back Jimmy Sutch (Hagerstown, MD/St. James) raced 32 yards for a touchdown to give the Rams a 42-13 advantage with 23 seconds left in the third quarter.

The Rams completed the scoring when senior running back Vincent Riggs (Poolesville, MD/Poolesville) dashed 11 yards for a score with 6:06 left in the fourth quarter.

The Rams amassed 517 yards of total offense in the contest.

Redshirt-freshman linebacker Brian Taylor (Elkridge, MD/Long Reach) paced the Rams defense with nine tackles. Senior strong safety Jerome Quinata (Woodbridge, VA/C.D. Hylton) added eight tackles, while senior outside linebacker Joey Hooks (Montgomery Village, MD/Watkins Mill) recorded seven stops.

#### A REIGN OF EXCELLENCE

Head Coach Monte Cater is now in his 21st season at the helm of the Shepherd football program. The Rams have had a great deal of success since Cater arrived in 1987 as they have won 10 WVIAC titles in 20 seasons. In that time the Rams have made two trips to the NAIA Playoffs and four trips to the NCAA II Playoffs with a pair of back-to-back appearances (1998-99 and 2005-06). If the Rams score 24 or more points, there is a good chance they will come out on top. Shepherd owns a 226-9 (.962) all-time record when reaching the magical 24-point mark. Included in that record is a 99-6 (.943) record since 1990 and a 105-8 (.929) mark under Cater.

The Rams sport a 340-75-26 (.800) all-time record when holding the opposition to 14 points or less. Currently, Shepherd has won 66 of its last 67 games when holding the opposition to 14 or less and owns an 88-3-1 (.962) record since 1990 when turning the trick. Shepherd is 99-7-1 (.929) under Cater in such games.

Shepherd is 117-93-26 (.550) all-time in games decided by seven points or less. Shepherd has a 35-21-1 (.622) record since 1990 and a 39-30-1 (.564) mark under Cater in games decided by seven or less.

150

Another key to victory is the Shepherd running game. Shepherd is 135-23-2 (.850) since 1980 in games that it rushes for 150 or more yards. Since 1990, the record is 83-11-1 (.878) and under Cater it is 93-17-1 (.842).

### Anything Less than 100

Defensively, the Rams will try to contain the running game and force teams to pass. If they hold the opposition to under 100 yards rushing, the odds on a win go up dramatically. Since 1980, the Rams are 114-16-1 (.874) when holding teams to less than 100 yards. Since 1990, Shepherd is 79-11 (.877) in such games and 87-14 (.861) under Cater.

Concord (0-6, 0-4) is coming off a 25-22 loss to West Virginia State last Saturday. Freshman quarterback **Thomas Frazier** (6-0, 190) led the Mountain Lions as he completed 19-of-37 passes for 181 yards and three touchdowns.

Freshman wide receiver **Nathan Tanner** (6-3, 180) led the receiving corps with nine catches for 62 yards. Freshman wide receiver **DeJuan Franklin** (5-9, 165) added four receptions for 59 yards.

The ground game was led by freshman running back **Orlando Bryant** (5-9, 170). Bryant rushed for 93 yards on only eight carries. Senior quarterback **Dustin Greenwood** (6-2, 190) added 40 yards on 10 carries.

The Concord defense was led by senior linebacker **Tank Tunstalle** (6-3, 240). Tunstalle who recorded a game-high 16 tackles with nine solo stops. He added two tackles-for-loss (-3 yards) and a pass breakup.

Freshman defensive tackle **Thomas Hearons** (6-2, 250) added 11 stops with six solos. He also forced a fumble, recovered a fumble, and blocked a kick. Senior linebacker **Ola Adams** (6-1, 200) added nine tackles.

Junior safety **Joe Thomas** (5-11, 200) led the Mountain Lion secondary with a pair of interceptions returned for 41 yards.
