

### #5 SHEPHERD (7-0, 4-0) vs. WV WESLEYAN (2-5, 1-3)

**RAM STADIUM • SHEPHERDSTOWN, WV**  
**SATURDAY, OCTOBER 28, 2006 • 1 P.M.**

SHEPHERDSTOWN, W.Va. -- Junior running back **Dervon Wallace** (Lusby, MD/Calvert) rushed 18 times for 107 yards and three touchdowns to lead fifth-ranked Shepherd University to a 42-0 win over Concord University in WVIAC football action on Homecoming at Ram Stadium last Saturday.

Wallace scored on a five-yard run with 11:57 left in the first quarter to give the Rams a 7-0 lead. The score was set up when junior cornerback **Cameron Mason** (Winchester, VA/James Wood) blocked a Concord punt and returned it to the Concord five yard line.

Mason's standout play earned him **WVIAC Special Teams Player of the Week** honors.

Senior quarterback **Dan Chlebowski** (Greencastle, PA/Greencastle-Antrim) scored on a two-run scamper with 28 seconds remaining in the first quarter. An interception by junior cornerback **Ayo Ijelu** (Germantown, MD/Northwest) set up the touchdown.

Wallace scored on a six-yard run with 8:04 left in the half to give the Rams a 21-0 advantage.

The Ram took a 28-0 lead into intermission when sophomore quarterback **Tyler Lazear** (Bethesda, MD/Walt Whitman) teamed with junior wide receiver **Mark Springirth** (Germantown, MD/Watkins Mill) on a 29-yard scoring strike.

Wallace tallied his third touchdown of the day on a two-yard run with 10:25 left in the third quarter to give the Rams a 35-0 lead.

Junior running back **Vincent Riggs** (Poolesville, MD/Poolesville) scored on a one-yard plunge with 3:47 left in the third quarter for the game's final score.

Chlebowski completed 9-of-11 passes for 98 yards, while Lazear connected on 7-of-10 passes for 68 yards. Rusty Coeburn completed 7-of-18 passes for 58 yards for the Mountain Lions.

Riggs rushed eight times for 45 yards and senior running back **Bryan Wright** (Augusta, WV/Hampshire/WVU) added 44 more on 10 carries.

Springirth led the Rams receivers with four catches for 56 yards. Sophomore tight end **Ryan Lavin** (Centreville, VA/Westfield) added four receptions for 36 yards. Concord's Dustin Greenwood had five receptions for 53 yards.

Sophomore linebacker **Louis Corum** (Manassas, VA/Westfield) led the Rams with seven tackles. Ola Adams had a game-high 14 tackles for Concord.

#### A REIGN OF EXCELLENCE

**Head Coach Monte Cater** is now in his 20th season at the helm of the Shepherd football program. The Rams have had a great deal of success since Cater arrived in 1987 as they have won nine WVIAC titles in 19 seasons. In that time the Rams have made two trips to the NAIA Playoffs and also earned back-to-back trips to the NCAA II Playoffs in 1998 and 1999. The Rams gained their third trip to the NCAA II Playoffs in 2005. Below is a list of where Cater ranks on the all-time victories and all-time titles lists in the WVIAC.

If the Rams score 24 or more points, there is a good chance they will come out on top. Shepherd owns a 218-9 (.960) all-time record when reaching the magical 24-point mark. Included in that record is a 91-6 (.938) record since 1990 and a 97-8 (.924) mark under Cater.

The Rams sport a 332-75-26 (.797) all-time record when holding the opposition to 14 points or less. Currently, Shepherd has won 58 of its last 59 games when holding the opposition to 14 or less and owns an 80-3-1 (.958) record since 1990 when turning the trick. Shepherd is 91-7-1 (.924) under Cater in such games.

Shepherd is 115-92-26 (.540) all-time in games decided by seven points or less. Shepherd has a 34-20-1 (.618) record since 1990 and a 38-29-1 (.514) mark under Cater in games decided by seven or less.

150

Another key to victory is the Shepherd running game. Shepherd is 128-22-2 (.848) since 1980 in games that it rushes for 150 or more yards. Since 1990, the record is 76-10-1 (.879) and under Cater it is 86-16-1 (.839).

### Anything Less than 100

Defensively, the Rams will try to contain the running game and force teams to pass. If they hold the opposition to under 100 yards rushing, the odds on a win go up dramatically. Since 1980, the Rams are 108-16-1 (.868) when holding teams to less than 100 yards. Since 1990, Shepherd is 73-11 (.869) in such games and 81-14 (.852) under Cater.

West Virginia Wesleyan (2-5, 1-3 WVIAC) is coming off a 14-0 loss to West Virginia State at home last Saturday. The Bobcats will be looking to snap a four-game losing streak today.

Leading the way for the Bobcats was junior running back **Ben Vance** (5-9, 221). Vance rushed 12 times for 66 yards. Junior running back **Greg Duncan** (6-0, 200) added 59 yards on 12 carries.

Junior quarterback **Devin Ramos** (6-3, 220) completed 8-of-23 passes for 155 yards with one interception. He was sacked four times by the Yellow Jackets.

The Bobcat receiving group was led by Duncan and junior wide receiver **Alex Puente** (6-4, 210). Duncan hauled in five passes for 78 yards, while Puente added two catches for 17 yards.

Junior wide receiver **Bryan Overton** (6-3, 205), the team's leading receiver, added one catch for 38 yards.

Junior defensive back **Ryan McCullough** (6-1, 205) led the Bobcat defense with a team-high 10 tackles, including seven solos.

Sophomore linebacker **Donovan Godwin** (5-10, 215) had nine tackles, while junior defensive end **Jason Perez** (6-0, 220) and senior defensive back **Mott Gaymon** (6-0, 190) each chipped in with eight stops. Sophomore defensive lineman **Tyrone Moses** (5-9, 275) added seven tackles.

Junior defensive lineman **Ryan Young** (5-9, 245) recorded a sack and two tackles-for-loss.

Freshman punter **Derek Moore** (6-1, 225) punted five times for a 34.8 average with a long punt of 41 yards.

The versatile Overton led the Bobcat return game with two kickoff returns for 68 yards, including a 39-yarder.

Junior defensive back **Domonique Staten** (5-8, 175) added two punt returns for 35 yards with along return of 20 yards. He also added a kickoff return for seven yards.

Junior kicker **Stephen Link** (6-1, 230), who did not attempt any field goals in the game, has connected on 4-of-6 field goals for the year. He is also 12-for-12 in extra points.
